I, Rabbi Moshe Green, am the dean of Yeshiva D'Monsey, which is located at 14 Roman Blvd. Monsey, NY. I have been the dean of this yeshiva for over 30 years.

Thousands of former students over the last 30 years have requested me to officiate at their weddings. It is my obligation to ensure that everything will proceed according to the laws of Moses and Israel when I officiate.

In the event that I am asked to officiate at a wedding of a remarriage of a woman, I conduct a thorough investigation as to the authenticity of her Jewish Get. If I deem the Get invalid, I will not officiate, as I know that the woman may not remarry under those circumstances.

A Get in which Rabbi Tzvi Dov Abraham has a part in is not a universally accepted Get. Rather, it is deemed extremely controversial, to say the least. A broad spectrum of the Orthodox women will not accept such a Get. Men will not remarry a woman who has a divorce through such a Get.

The reason for this stringency, that a woman may not remarry with a Get that is in any way controversial, is because offspring of that union will be forever blemished and unable to marry into the Jewish people.

Therefore, I reiterate, I will never ever officiate at any wedding which a bride was previously divorced by Rabbi Abraham's Get as it is definitely a Get which I believe is not worthy of being accepted.
